Dancer + Athlete = Dancelete

Rehearsals

- Included with your tuition. All group dances are entitled to one 30-minute rehearsal each week from September through the recital.
- Group dances will have an additional 30 minutes or more, of rehearsal each Saturday starting the third week of January and until the 3rd competition.
- Solos, Duets and Trios are entitled to 15 hours of rehearsal. That averages to one 30 minutes rehearsal each week from September through to the end of the competition season. Any additional rehearsals must be scheduled as private lessons.
- Rehearsal for group dances that are going to Nationals are covered by Nationals fees.

Attendance

- Danceletes are expected to attend all rehearsals and classes except for extenuating circumstances, which may include important family obligations, religious commitments, or illness
- We reserve the right to change casting because of missed classes or rehearsals.
- If a dancer misses 2+ Saturday rehearsals, casting will be changed.
- As indicated by the schedule, some rehearsals are mandatory. We reserve the right to change casting if a mandatory rehearsal is missed without a doctor's note.
- All parents must attend the parent meeting on Monday September 9th at 8:15p.
- The first 3 competitions are mandatory.
- No dancer will be allowed to drop out after September 30th. A \$300 fine will be issued to any dancer who does drop after this date.

Shoes, Make-Up, Attire & Team Jackets

- All dancers must have a Performance Team Jacket.
- During performance team rehearsals, dancers should wear a leotard with black jazz pants, black leggings, or black shorts.
- For performances it is important that all dancers wear the same style of shoes and tights. The following are the required brand of shoe for performances.

- Make Up All dancers must wear the same make up. The Dance Connection will notify you of the proper make-up kit to purchase.
- Low Bun –Please make sure your bun does not have any bumps. A smooth circular bun looks professional and clean.
- Specific information on your dancer's required hairstyle will be released with costume information.

Tuition and fees

- Pricing for all competition dances includes costumes and entrance fees for 4 competitions.
- Extra fees apply for the 5th competition, nationals and World Dance Championship.
- Fees for the optional competition are as follows.
 - o Solo \$130
 - Duets/Trios \$85 per dancer
 - o Group Dances \$60 per dancer
- Fees for Nationals are as follows.
 - o Solo \$180
 - o Duets/Trios \$90 per dancer
 - o Group Dances \$70 per dancer

At the Competitions

- No photography or video during the show or in the theater. We could be disqualified if you
 photograph or video. Ask a competition staff person if you have any questions about when or
 where it's appropriate to photograph.
- All dancers must dress appropriately for competitions. The attire guidelines are expected to be followed for the entire weekend that you are at the competition, whether your child has yet to perform or is done.
- When not in costume dancers should wear black leggings, their warm up jacket (zipped up) and black jazz shoes, Nikes, or hip-hop sneakers.
- All dancers should be presentable and well composed for the entire weekend, whether they are watching, warming up, practicing, or just hanging out.
- Danceletes are expected to arrive with make up and hair ready for their first dance.
- Danceletes wear black leggings and warm ups when travelling to the competition. Danceletes should carry their costume to competitions and should NOT wear their costume to the competition.
- We encourage dancers to watch their teammates perform either before or after their own performances.
- Please do not wear promotional attire from the competition company during the competition. However you can wear promotional clothing from the competition during class provided it's appropriate class-wear.
- Absolutely no temporary tattoos, stamps, or jewelry.
- Dancers that accept a special award, a golden ticket, or for go up on stage for any reason any must stand in 3rd or 5th position, hold the award in front of them and smile.
- Stay with your team! All danceletes are encouraged to stay together with each other.

Summer

- We know that summer vacation is important and being able to schedule in advance is necessary. When planning your vacation, the best time to go away is July after Nationals (last week of June or 1st week of July) and before World Dance Championships (usually the first week of August).
- We offer classes for our danceletes to take throughout the summer. Danceletes should be present for any and all classes they can, when they are home.
